

SPORTSMANSHIP

A primary goal of the sports program is to teach sportsmanship. Student athletes, student spectators, district personnel, and public spectators are expected to support this goal.

Rules of Conduct

The Principal and designated personnel shall develop rules of conduct for athletic events. These rules shall be published in student and employee handbooks and disseminated to district patrons using the method deemed most appropriate, effective, and cost efficient by the Superintendent.

The Superintendent, principal(s), athletic directors, district security personnel, other authorized designees, and law enforcement may evict violators of these rules from the athletic event, and the Superintendent or Principal may prohibit and/or restrict attendance at future events. In addition, district students and employees violating these rules may be subject to disciplinary consequences in accordance with district policy and law.
